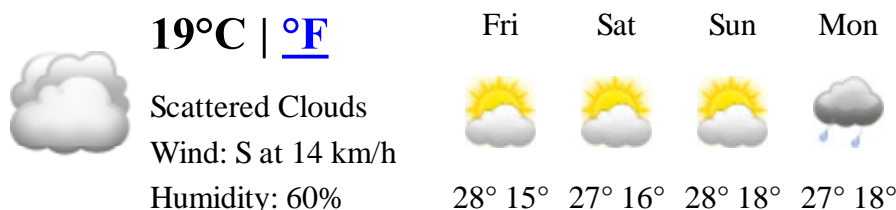

Okay so it wasn't the final email, but this one may be.

A couple of you have informed me that I missed a couple of things. So here are the basics of what is on each boat. Feel free to visit the website if you wish to see more information: <http://www.ripples.com.au/resort.php>

1. All vessels are self contained with crockery, cutlery, glassware, cooking utensils and pots/pans.
2. Toilet paper, dishwashing liquid, t-towels, chux and scourers are provided.

3. Doonas and pillows are provided. Just bring your own bed linen, towel and personal effects
4. Linen can be hired (sheets, pillow case, towel, bath mat and guest soap) for \$14.50 per person.
5. Food and drink remains your responsibility. Please note that the water on board the vessels is perfectly fine to drink.
6. All vessels are fitted with quiet, four stroke outboard motors.
7. All vessels are equipped with hot/cold water, shower and toilet.
8. All vessels have refrigerators, cooktop, griller and oven (no oven on Budget Riverboat 28')
9. First aid kit, tide chart, torch and matches are provided.
10. Detailed maps are supplied on board.

FICTION: we are not going to have a good time.

Three more sleeps until we are lazing about drinking beers on the Hawkesbury. So I need to clarify a couple of things for you, so that we can get this thing rolling without a hitch.

- **TIMING:**
  - o We will need to leave the Marina area at Brooklyn **NO LATER THAN 7PM.** which means you will need to be there no later than 6pm. For directions and ways of getting there see below:
- **WHERE IS IT?**
  - o We will be moored off the marina of Brooklyn Boat Harbour. If you go on Google maps you will see some 'Baths' at the end of the point at McKell Park, and we will be ferrying people in and out on dingy's from this point. There is a bottle shop at the marina there, and everyone should buy a bag of ice if they want to use the esky's on board the boat (of which there are a couple).
- **HOW DO I GET THERE?**
  - o You have many, many options...actually just two:
    - § The easiest if you have no car is to get the train from Central on the Newcastle/Central Coast line. **Very important: Make sure you get the train that stops at Hawkesbury River Train Station.** The last train you can catch from Central to get you there on time is 6:33pm.     - § Car: Easy driving, but you will get stuck in traffic if you leave too late. Head for Newcastle and exit immediately after you go over the Hawkesbury River, then follow signs for Brooklyn. I'd allow 90 mins from Sydney.
- **MEALS – what happens?**
  - o Check again what meals you are responsible for below. You will need to cook for your entire boat on your particular meal, so make sure you have enough for 10. I've cc'd everyone here so you can get in touch with them if you haven't already arranged what you're cooking.
- **ANYTHING ELSE I NEED?**
  - o Something to float on, a smile, and beer!!
