To those honoring the contract you signed up with (99.9% of you), thank you for your shining example!



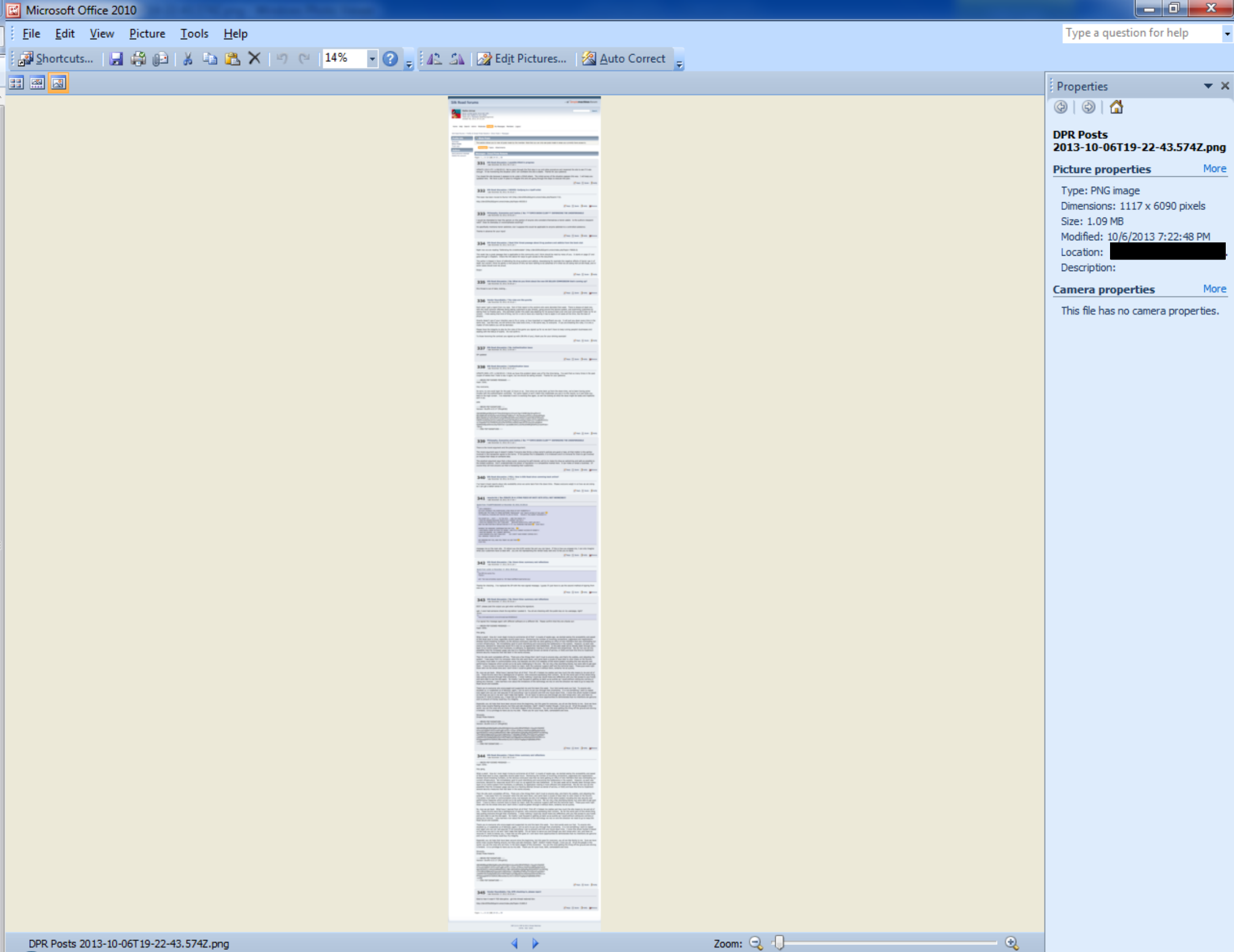
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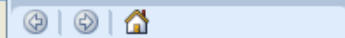


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
